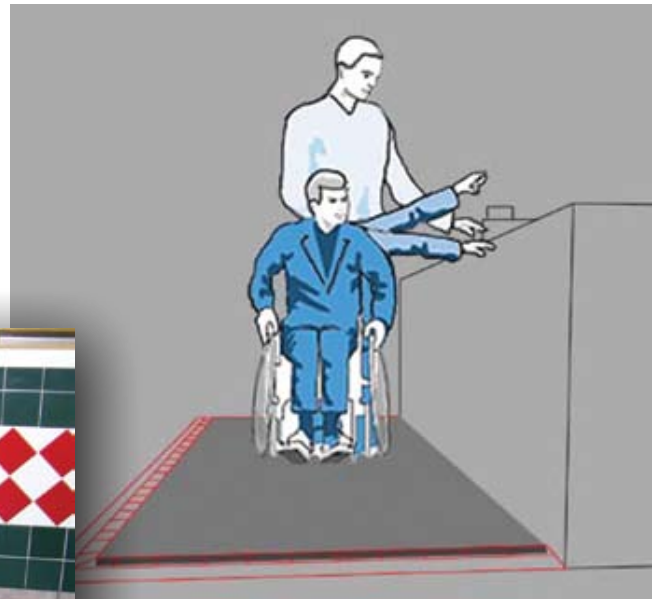

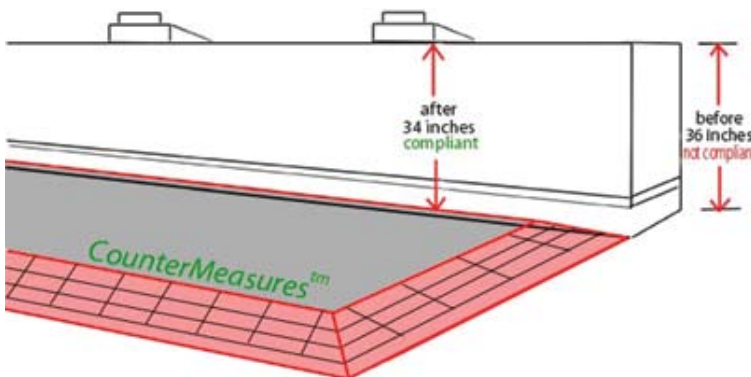
Available in various colors, these products feature years of maintenance free use and are easy to clean. They also provide for an aggressive slip resistant surface while providing for access code compliance.

CODE WIZARD SAYS...

Q: What is the **required counter height** for food service counters?

A: ADAAG, local and state codes vary as to the exact height(s) required for counters. This is determined if there is food consumed, or if there is service provided at these counters. However, **in most instances 34" maximum counter height is the requirement** for food and consumer service counter areas.
